

High Plains Drift Inn Lodging Agreement

Our ranch isn't exactly a hotel nor are we outfitters so most people don't know quite what to expect. All this information (and more) is on the website but who reads every page of a website! So we put together this list to make sure you are aware of the highlights. Please contact us if you have any questions.

Solar

- The Ranch is off grid. We do not have power outlets in the cabins.
- We recommend you to bring vehicle chargers or battery packs to keep your devices charged as you drive in and out of your hunting spots.
- Please turn off the lights and heaters when you are not in the cabin to keep from draining the system. If the solar system gets too low, it automatically cuts off everything.

General

- It is your responsibility to know Colorado Hunting Laws. For example many of our clients do not understand that they must leave evidence of sex attached to the hind quarters.
- Some cabins do not have indoor toilets, there are outside bathrooms and a shower house.
- Cabins are bunkhouse style and you may share a cabin with others. Earplugs may be a good idea :)
- Please bring Cash to pay your balance or call ahead to use a card (there will be a processing fee to use a card)
- CPAP machines are required to be battery operated or you must have a silent generator.
- Regular generators must be turned off at 9pm.
- We will recommend one area for you to hunt that we have scouted and where we believe you will find elk. If you don't like this area, remember this is public land and you are welcome to hunt other areas of your choosing. We would appreciate it if you would let us know where you are hunting in case of you having an accident, we will know where to look for you and also we will not recommend other hunters to go to that area.
- The roads in the area are old logging and mining roads which have not been improved much since the turn of the century! This is a blessing in that it discourages a lot of traffic but it can be tough on equipment. Some people find it annoying to be bounced around as they drive.
- Cabins are heated with propane heaters. The government requires all heaters to have shut off oxygen sensors, due to the altitude, the heaters can shut off randomly. Bringing sleeping bags is a good idea to ensure your comfort.
- The HPDI is a working ranch, and congested driveways and roads can become a problem

with 20 or more guests parking trucks and trailers all over. Once your equipment is unloaded it is required for you to park outside of the fenced yard. We ask all guests to be courteous to our staff and other guests by parking in the designated parking areas.

- To purchase a license in Colorado you will need proof of Hunters Safety/Education and valid ID
- As per food regulations, each meal is served for 2 hours.
- Dinner will be served about 1 and a half hours after sunset. Restaurant doors will be open 30 minutes before serving time.

Archery Season

- Breakfast is served at 8 am during Archery season.

Rifle Season

- Breakfast is served one hour before sunrise.
- We recommend rifle hunters bring chains, tow rope, and a shovel for their truck in case the roads get bad.
